


We are working on the core word 'want'

- Most commonly used words
- Can be used in lots of different activities throughout the day, in a variety of places and with a range of people
- Takes the focus away from labelling

Dominant hand is held with the palm facing the chest. Hand moves down and away from the chest.

Ideas for modelling 'want'

Requesting 'I want more', 'want a turn', 'want jigsaw'

Reject/refuse 'not want', 'don't want that'

Commenting or giving information 'he **wants** that'

Questioning/choice making do you **want**?', 'Do you **want** toast or yogurt?'

Answer questions 'I want toast'

Activities

Choosing food and drink

Games such as Pop Up Pirate, lotto, jigsaws

Choosing clothes

Choosing people to work or play with, places to go, programmes to watch

Outdoor activities such as sand play, swing, playing with a ball

Choosing colours
