


We are working on the core word 'eat'

Activities

Reject/refuse Playing in the home corner

'not eat'

Snack time

Commenting or giving instructions

Lunch/dinner time

'eat that', 'I want to eat', 'mummy eat' Lu

Questioning/choice making 'shall we have something to **eat**?', 'what do you

want to eat?' 'what are you eating?'

Offering choices

Tea party

Labeling

'eat apple'

Feeding a hand puppet

Expressing likes/dislikes

'I like to eat chips' 'I don't like to eat cabbage'

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
