Ideas for modelling 'Finished'

Reject/refuse
'not **finished**'

Commenting or giving instructions
'all **finished**', 'my turn is **finished**', 'bubbles
are **finished**' 'Wait, I've not **finished**'

Questioning/choice making
'Are you **finished**?', 'who has **finished**?'
'do you want more or **finished**'

Sharing information
'dinner is **finished**'

Turn taking games

Use with visual timetables/'first and then'/'now
and next' boards

Meal times

Watching TV/videos

Building with Lego etc.
