Ideas for modelling 'Finished'

Activities

Reject/refuse 'not **finished'**

Click clack cars, racing games

Commenting or giving instructions 'all **finished**', 'my turn is **finished**', 'bubbles are **finished**' 'Wait, I've not **finished**'

Bubbles

Turn taking games

Questioning/choice making 'Are you **finished**?', 'who has **finished**?' 'do you want more or **finished**?'

Use with visual timetables/'first and then'/'now and next' boards

Meal times

Watching TV/videos

Building with Lego etc.

Role play with dolls or teddies

Sharing information 'dinner is **finished**'

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
